

2009 Four Corners Photography Tours

Nostalgic photographic memories from the Four Corners, sw United States, are rampant. Let me tell you just a few:

- A multi-column, multi-row panorama of an ancient Kiva at Canyonlands.
- A rainy, mud-slick run to capture a rainbow over the Colorado at Canyonlands.
- Climbing down into Cedar Mesa canyon to capture Moon House.
- A very windy Mesa Verde sunset capture of Sleeping Ute Mountain.
- A sunset capture of Totem Pole at Monument Valley.
- A quiet evening posing a captivating, evocative HDR view of Shiprock.
- Lying on my side to capture a Bisti cover for New Mexico Magazine.
- A Magic Hour capture of *Moon to King's Rook* in the Bisti.
- Sandhill cranes at Bosque del Apache NWR.
- Moonrise Ridge, Bisti...

Our 2009 Tours are designed for *specific moonrise capture objectives* as well as *general Nature photography*. We really like to shoot during Magic Hour, that hour around dawn and dusk.

Because of high contrast capture during Magic Hour, we use high dynamic range photography for our standard. We can both show you how to perform such a capture and discuss quick Lightroom workflow techniques for putting together truly evocative HDR images.

For general photography, in daylight between shoots (and travel if necessary), we are prepared to talk about technical aspects of digital photography and advanced workflow in Adobe Photoshop and Lightroom. If the client is interested, we can also share trials and tribulations of preparing, competing, and occasionally winning digital competitions at local and state levels.

If you would like to simply shoot in some of the Four Corners areas listed above, drop us an e-mail so we can decide how to adequately cover the ground you choose yet take you there, then teach specific aspects of rapid travel workflow in Nature.

If you're really into tantalizing foreground and exotic moon shots, come with us to a spectacular Bisti place called Moonrise Ridge. There, we plan to shoot moonrise and sunset one evening - then moonset and sunrise early the very next morning (in May)... technical and HDR panorama challenges of this shoot require advanced digital photography skills!
